



In-Home Support

xavier Children's Support Network assists families to access a variety of in-home supports.

Families may need a carer to assist with their child's personal care needs such as bathing, dressing, eating or with more specialised care such as oxygen support, suction, enteral feeding or giving medication.

In-home support can be offered in various ways such as:

- ☂ A trained Support Worker from Xavier's Community Team may assist the family in caring for their child with a disability;*
- ☂ Financial assistance may be provided to assist to pay for a carer who the family have chosen; and*
- ☂ The family can be linked with another community agency that is able to assist.*

In-home support may be provided on a regular basis for a few hours each week or periodically during stressful times, depending on the family's needs.
